A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA
AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR A CONCEPTUAL DESIGN OF A
LOOPED TRAIL FOR THE WOODARD CANYON TRAIL PROJECT TO
HAPPY TRAILS, INC OF FAIRBANKS, ALASKA AND AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE THE
APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, Council passed Resolution 26-041 for a Route Identification and Conceptual
Planning for a Low-Impact Looped Hiking Trail above Karen Hornaday Park; and

WHEREAS, Staff released an RFP for a Conceptual Design of a Looped Hiking Trail for
the Woodard Canyon Project ; and

WHEREAS, Three proposals were received for the RFP and evaluated and scored by a
committee made up of six staff members coming from 3 separate departments; and

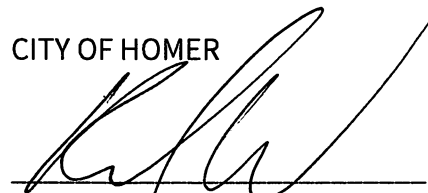
WHEREAS, The winning proposal was submitted by Happy Trails, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska hereby
awards the Contract for the Conceptual Design of a Looped Hiking Trail for the Woodard
Canyon Trail Project to Happy Trails, Inc. of Fairbanks, Alaska in the amount of \$15,060 and
authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute the appropriate documents.

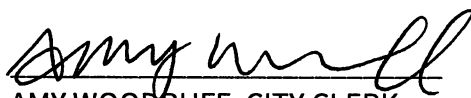
