Svedlund Subdivision; a triangular 14 piece of land immediately adjacent to their property (Lot 6 A) and fronting on Pioneer Avenue; 15 and 16 17 WHEREAS, Acquisition of this small piece of land will resolve a setback encroachment 18 on the side lot line and is part of the larger redevelopment project for the Pioneer Building and 19 new site plan approved by the Planning Commission through Conditional Use Permit 13-06; and 20 21 WHEREAS, The parcel proposed for sale is not needed by the City and disposal will not 22 impede future development of the lot; and/ 23 24 WHEREAS, The Homer City Council approved the sale of this 385 square feet in 25 concept through adoption of Resolution 13-069; and 26 27 WHEREAS. The parcel proposed for sale is too small to be developed and would be of 28 no use to anyone other than the Halls and therefore, a public sale is not warranted and direct 29 negotiations between the City and the Halls pursuant to HCC 18.12.050 is necessary and 30 appropriate; and 31 32 WHEREAS, HCC 18.12.020 provides that an appraisal is not required if property does 33 not exceed \$1,000 in value in the current tax assessment records of the Kenai Peninsula 34 Borough; and 35

WHEREAS, The current Borough assessment for the parcel to be sold is \$1,655.50.
