6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,
7 ESTABLISHING A SUSTAINABLE ANIMAL CONTROL REVIEW
8 COMMITTEE TO STRENGTHEN SUSTAINABILITY OF THE
9 SHELTER.

11 WHEREAS, The City has contracted out Animal Control services for over 30 years; and

12
13 WHEREAS, In 2005 with tremendous support and effort from the community and
14 Homer Animal Friends, the City of Homer built a new Animal Shelter; and

15
16 WHEREAS, In these constrained fiscal times, it is prudent to review how the
17 sustainability of providing animal control for the City of Homer can be strengthened; and

18
19 WHEREAS, It would be beneficial to establish a Sustainable Animal Control Review
20 Committee (SACRC) to assist the City with increasing revenue and reducing expenses at the
21 shelter.

22
23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Homer hereby establishes the
24 Sustainable Animal Control Review Committee (SACRC).

25
26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Committee membership shall be the Mayor or one
27 member of the City Council, the Police Chief or their designee, the Finance Director or their
28 designee, a member of Homer Animal Friends, a Veterinarian licensed to practice in the State
29 of Alaska, and a representative of the Homer Animal Shelter Contractor.

30
31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee should select within its membership a
32 chairperson to run meetings and provide the clerk's office with agenda content, a vice chair
33 in the chair's absence, and a secretary to take notes at meetings.

35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the scope of work shall include:

 - 38 • Review of animal control fine and fee schedule
 - 39 • Review of animal boarding policy
 - 40 • Review of energy use at the shelter
 - 41 • Review of opportunities for collaboration with Homer Animal Friends

42 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Committee shall establish its own work schedule
43 and shall be disbanded when the initial scope of work is complete or December 1, 2015,
44 whichever comes first.

46 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is authorized to advertise for parties
47 interested in serving as the veterinarian and Homer Animal Friends member.
