14	the harbor, alternative lighting methods for the high mast lights at the Fish Dock were			
15	explored; and

17	WHEREAS, Harbor personnel tested lighting options over the course of several months			
18	and concluded the light emitting plasma (LEP) lamps are better suited for the taller poles on			
19	the Fish Dock; and			
20				
21	WHEREAS, The LEP lamps reduce energy costs in half and their distinctive white light			
22	offers the ability to cut through fog and snow; additionally, they produce more useable light			
23	on the ground allowing a reduction in the number of fixtures on Fish Dock from 10 to 8 with a			
24	cost savings realized within a few years.
