- 1 » Tiered earthen stadium seating
- 2 » Event space
- 3 » Licensed sales
- 4 » Vendor space during events
- 5 » Clear brush to 8' beyond fenceline
- 6 » Improve existing access
- 7 » Additional parking (15 vehicles)
- 8 » Maintain current parking area
- 9 » Additional bluff parking
- 10 » Pedestrian safety measures (barriers to delineate traffic, crosswalk, speedbumps)
- 11 » Existing accessible digger added to sandbox w/ new accessible pathway
- 12 » Thin brush for nature play opportunities
- 13 » Reprogrammed park space
- 14 » Campsite area - thin vegetation, level sites, improve access
- 15 » Maintain water access to mobile restroom
- 16 » Inspect drainage to confirm improvement measures needed
- 17 » Maintain disc golf
- 18 » Install utility pole with flood light

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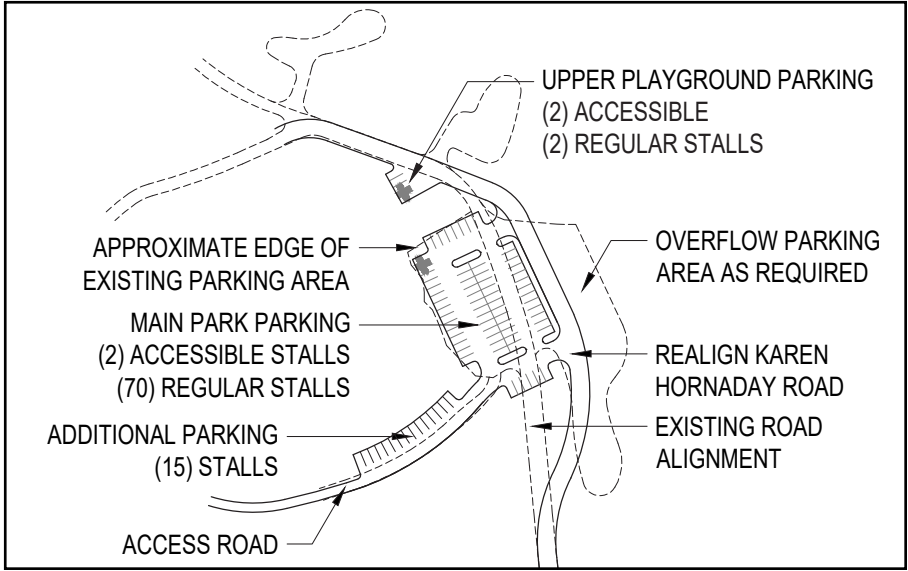
