ITEM 2 – Revised Lighting Plan (Sheet E1.2)

Included in this addendum is a revised Sheet E1.2, reflecting change in lighting and camera locations. The sheet reflects the installation of 8 poles along the south side of the storage/laydown area, rather than the 9 poles, as were previously shown, along the northern side. Camera locations also revised. Please refer to the revision note, on the drawing, for instructions concerning coordination of alpha numeric designators through the package.

ITEM 3 – Fiber Termination Clarification (Revision to Note 7, Sheet E1.6)

Revise note 7 to read:

PROVIDE TERMINATION OF ALL FIBERS, AFL FUSECONNECT FUSION-SPLICED FIELD-TERMINATED OR OWNER-APPROVED EQUAL, HIGH-PERFORMANCE, SINGLE-MODE, TYPE-SC, NO-EPOXY/NO-POLISH, UPC, SINGLE MODE CONNECTOR HOUSINGS SHALL BE THE COLOR BLUE; COORDINATE CONNECTOR BOOT TYPE AND SIZE WITH THE PROVIDED CABLE; UNICAM CONNECTORS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE TO THE OWNER AND SHALL NOT BE USED.

ITEM 4 – Oral, Telephonic, and Facsimile Bids

Oral, telephonic, and facsimile Bids will not be considered. Modification by facsimile, of Bids already submitted, will be considered if received prior to the time fixed in the Invitation to Bid. ITEM 5 – Will the Contractor be responsible for Homer Electric Association (HEA) fees?

All fees charged by HEA to provide electric service to the Contractor provided load center (shown on Sheet E1.4) will be paid for by the City. The junction box near the proposed load center is not capable of supplying secondary voltage. It will require HEA to install a transformer. The cost of installing this new transformer is the responsibility of the City.

ITEM 6 - Can we use PVC conduit in lieu of HDPE for electrical UG runs?
